	Policy Title Private Land Owner Snow Removal Guidelines

Purpose

To prohibit private landowners from pushing snow across County roads and piling excess snow in the County right of ways.

Statement

When excess snow is moved across gravel roads and piled in right of ways, safety for both road users and County of Stettler No. 6 equipment operators is compromised. It also negatively impacts the quality of the roads and quantity of gravel remaining on the County Roads.

Procedure

The County of Stettler No. 6 will enforce the following guidelines with respect to private landowners moving snow over County roads:

1. The County of Stettler No. 6 reserves the right to control snow removal and placement on their Roads and in their right of ways.
2. When Private Landowners remove or relocate snow from their property, they are prohibited from pushing the snow onto or across any County road or right of way.
3. Failure to comply with the policy will result in the landowner assuming the liability for any and all damages that were incurred as a result of the piled snow.
4. Notices of non-compliance will be issued to first-time offenders by the Road Maintenance Supervisor. Repeat instances of non-compliance will be held responsible for damages as outlined in 3.
