RV Sites Canada withdraws 24-Hour work permit application

RV Sites Canada will adhere to County's current noise bylaw.

The County of Stettler and the developer, RV Sites Canada, mutually agreed that the issuance of a 24-hour work permit at the proposed Paradise Shores RV Resort development, is currently not in the best interest of either party.

RV Sites Canada voluntarily withdrew their application for a 24-hour permit, and will adhere to the County's current noise bylaw. The developer had originally applied for extended work-hour permit for a three-four week period as they prepare their site for the proposed RV Resort development.

Council has given the area structure plan (Bylaw 1588-18) and rezoning of the land (Bylaw 1589-18) first reading, and will hold a Public Hearing on March 17, 2018 at 1:00 PM at the Stettler District Agricultural Society Pavilion.
